YURTY Things to Do:

The Almighty Snow Brush:

Brush feet, pack, and friend off prior to entry.

Take brush to bathroom for seat sweeping.

Don't forget to prewarm seat with pants on.

Drinking Water:

Snowmelt: Stake out clean area, use clean shovel/containers, and/or collect from Yurt Roof.

Big Sheep Campers: Snowmelt or clean white bucket from creek.

Gear Drying Tips:

Hang skins/clothes on P-cords, screws, yurt cable.

Boot-liners: Wedge between Yurt rafters, using broom handle. Go high!

Boot-Shells go upside down under the cot.

Bathroom:

Use ski pole as occupied sign.

TP and hand gel are found in Tupperware box.

TP only in cat-hole, no garbage.

Don't forget to close the lid when finished.

Concentrate yellow snow in one spot.

Woodstove:

Half a stick of fire starter.

Use that bramble next to split wood pile to start.

Start twiggy, then small kindling, finally split wood. **Patience.**

Crack stove door quarter inch to draw better. Leave cracked until fire roaring.

Good split wood size for cozy fire, is the diameter of your forearm.

Split wood **before** consuming mind altering substances.

Lanterns:

CAREFUL LIGHTING. Turn off when not in use by closing tank valve and lantern gas control valve.
